Finishing Checklist to be completed by CUSTOMER

American Woodline is dedicated to providing quality furniture that is finished to our customer specifications. To assist us in performing the best possible results, we have established five levels to choose from. Please read the following, and select one that suits you best. Samples brought to us for matching that are from a different wood species than your purchase, will appear different even if the stain is exact. The variations in wood grain will always impact the final appearance of the final finish.

TAKE YOUR TIME CHOOSING A FINAL FINISH FOR YOUR PURCHASE. ONCE IT' FINISHED, WE CANNOT GO BACK AND APPLY A DIFFERENT COLOR!

Level One – Standard Specify Color Choice

American Woodline will finish your purchase with one of our standard finishes. American Woodline provides color samples on various wood species to provide you with an understanding of how your furniture will turn out. All real wood furniture may have slight variations in depth of color, and shading. This is due to the variations in density of the wood. In addition, colors reviewed in the warehouse lighting may appear different in your home. Select this level if you want your color to be like the show room samples, but recognize that the colors will vary slightly when your product is completed.

Level Two – Closely Mixed Stains or paints - \$50.00

If no prepared sample matches your sample or color preference, American Woodline will finish your purchase with a blended or mixed stain that closely resembles your selection, or a sample you provide to us. You understand that American Woodline does mixing by hand and eye, and we will do our very best to get as close to your final color as possible. Your preference is to get the color in the same ballpark, and do not require a total exact match. Select this option if no other color we offer is acceptable to you.

Level Three – Exactly Mixed Stains or paints - \$100.00

If no standard stain matches your sample or color preference and you desire an exact match for your existing furniture, American Woodline will mix a stain sample that we believe best matches your sample. We will stain a sample and send to you for your final approval before we proceed. If the sample does not meet with your approval, American woodline will send two more variations based upon your feedback. If more than three samples are needed to achieve your objective, an additional \$10.00 per sample will be added to the final invoice. Additional time will be needed for finishing your product.

Level Four – Distressing, two tones and glazing- \$125.00 & up

Distressing, two tones and glazing are all special finishes that require substantial time and patience to complete properly. For distressing, American Woodline offers an "Elegant Distressing" technique that provides a beautiful warm yet distressed appearance. We provide distressing on edges and high points to show the lighter colored wood underneath. The best results are obtained when there is a high contrast between the natural wood tone, and the paint or stain color. Two tones can be in any combination of paints or stains. Glazing can be the most complicated of finishing options. Glazing is very subjective and there are no two glazed pieces the same. The amount of glazing material applied, how long it is left on before being wiped off are all variables that are controlled by the painter. We request that glazing is done in stages, and the customer come back to the store to approve the appearance before we proceed.
